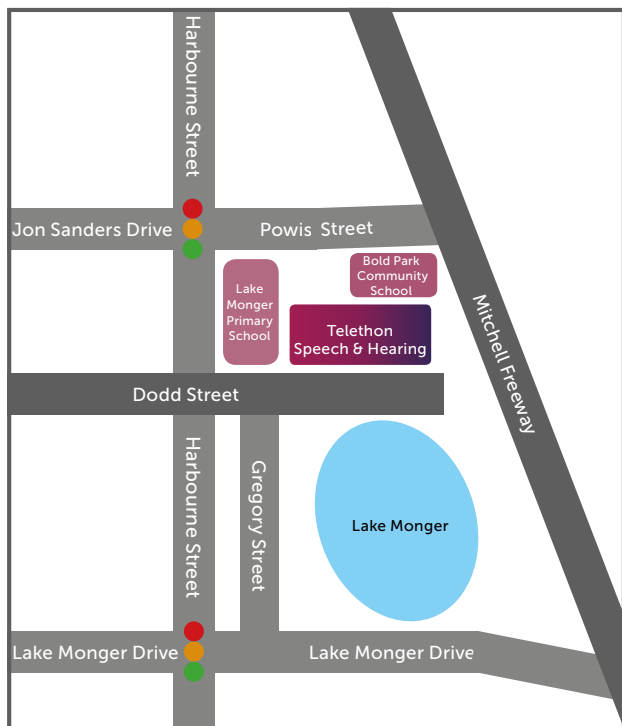


Location

Our Therapists

Our dynamic and experienced team of occupational therapists are passionate about working with *all* children, from birth through to adolescence.

We are dedicated to assisting children overcome challenges in their daily life by using their strengths, maximising developmental opportunities and making learning functional and fun.

What we offer

We provide comprehensive assessment of your child's functional skills and develop a tailored intervention program for your child.

Services include individual therapy sessions; joint speech pathology/occupational therapy (OT) sessions (where required); group and holiday programs and parent/caregiver workshops addressing various topics (as available).

We can provide help with:

Babies and Toddlers:

- Early movement skills and motor milestones
- Feeding and oral-motor skills
- Engagement and play skills
- Toileting and hygiene

Pre-Kindy and Pre-Schoolers:

- School readiness
- Fine motor skills such as drawing and cutting
- Gross motor skills such as coordination and balance
- Sensory and perceptual skills
- Attention, concentration and "thinking" skills
- Dressing, hygiene and toileting

Primary Students and Adolescents:

- Handwriting speed and accuracy
- Coordination and balance
- Strength and endurance
- Sensory and perceptual skills
- Concentration, planning and organisational skills

Frequently Asked Questions

Does my child need a GP's referral to receive services from the TSH Occupational Therapy Clinic?

No. Parents/caregivers can self-refer to the clinic for OT services without a referral. However, some children will be eligible for a Medicare Chronic Disease Management Plan or an Enhanced Primary Care Plan, initiated by your GP. This plan provides 5 Allied Health occasions of service in a calendar year for which you will receive a Medicare Rebate.

You may also be able to claim from your private health insurance provider; you will need to contact your provider to find out what you are covered for.

We are also approved providers for My Way and NDIS funding and also Better Start for Children with Disabilities.

Our fees structure is available upon request.

Do I stay with my child during the therapy session?

Yes. Our highly skilled therapists will work directly with you and your child using a family-centred approach.

We strive to coach and guide caregivers using strategies and techniques that are evidence-based and will assist your child's functional development to achieve outcomes that matter to your family.

Sessions are usually 45 minutes in duration.
